



# First Steps & Big Picture

**Budget & Priorities:** Your budget is your spending plan. Openly discuss what's most important (e.g., photography, venue).

- The average Rochester wedding (100 guests, 2025) is **\$20,000-\$35,000**.
- Average Ranges (100 guests, 2025):

Venue: \$2,500-\$8,000

Catering: \$30-\$70 per person
Photography: \$2,000-\$5,000

Flowers: \$1,500-\$3,500

o Cake: \$350-\$800

DJ/Music: \$800-\$2,000Attire: \$1,000-\$5,000

- Nail down 2-3 non-negotiables and research Rochester costs. Allocate your money to your values. Track spending.
- **Budget-Saving Tips:** Consider Friday/Sunday weddings or winter weddings (Jan-Mar) for discounts.

**Vision & Style:** Define your wedding's feel (e.g., Relaxed, Romantic, Modern). Create a mood board (Pinterest) with colors, textures, and light to communicate your vision. Ensure your style aligns with your venue for cohesive, stunning photos.



## **Pre-Wedding Timeline**

**12+ Months Before:** Set budget, priorities, guest count, draft guest list. Book venue & photographer/videographer. Reserve hotel blocks. Send save-the-dates (out-of-town guests).

**9–12 Months Before:** Select wedding party. Engagement session. Start dress shopping. Book caterer, officiant, band/DJ, rentals.

**6–9 Months Before:** Send save-the-dates (if not yet). Book florist, honeymoon, transportation, music/entertainment.

**3–6 Months Before:** Order invitations. Schedule dress fittings. Order cake. Book hair & make-up trials. Purchase rings. Plan rehearsal dinner. Apply for marriage license (within 6 months of wedding).

**1–3 Months Before:** Mail invitations. Track RSVPs. Finalize vendor details. Create seating chart. Break in shoes. Final outfit fittings. Photographer/videographer consultation.

**2–4 Weeks Before:** Final dress fitting. Confirm final guest count with caterer. Share day-of timeline with wedding party. Prepare vendor payments. Assemble emergency kit.

**1 Week Before:** Pack for honeymoon. Confirm all details with vendors. Final photographer meeting. Relax!



### The Legal Side

**Marriage License:** Apply online via Minnesota Official Marriage System (MOMS). Both must appear in person at Olmsted County Government Center (151 4th Street SE) to sign; book an appointment.

- Needed: Valid photo ID, Social Security numbers, full legal names, addresses, dates/places of birth, legal name after marriage for each. (Felony convictions may require a separate court process for name changes). Date last marriage ended (if applicable).
- **Fees:** \$115 standard, or \$40 with 12+ hours of premarital education (present signed, notarized educator's statement on letterhead).
- Validity: License valid for 6 months, usable anywhere in Minnesota. Both must be 18+.

**The Ceremony:** Performed by an authorized individual in MN (licensed/ordained minister 21+ with credentials filed, judge, certain court administrators). Two witnesses (16+) must sign the certificate.

**After Ceremony:** Officiant files license with Olmsted County Vital Records within 5 days. Order certified copies (approx. \$9 each) for name changes.

- The Floral Hall (Graham Park): Historic limestone hall, two-story mezzanine, seats 300. Affordable.

- Rochester Art Center: Sleek, modern, riverside location.
- The Castle (by Cameo Restaurant): Unique, historic, transformed event space.
- J.Powers at the Hilton: Modern, chic, terrace with city views.

# **Wedding Day Timeline**

A good timeline is key for relaxed, joyful photos.

### Why Time Matters for Photography:

- Golden Hour: Soft light after sunrise/before sunset for ethereal portraits.
- Relaxed Portraits: Ample time allows for creativity and genuine smiles.
- Detail Shots: Capturing flowers, tablescapes, attire.
- Candid Moments: Unscripted moments unfold naturally when not rushed.

Photographer's Tools: I offer clients a custom <u>Timeline</u> <u>Builder</u> and <u>Sunlight Calculator</u> to plan for optimal lighting.

Advice: Don't overschedule. Allow buffer time.



### **10-hour Timeline**

- 11am-12pm: Bride H&MU starts; detail shots (dress, rings, shoes, stationery).
- 12pm-1pm: Groom gets ready.
- 1pm-2pm: Bride H&MU ends; bride dresses; candids.
- 2pm-2:15pm: First Look.
- 2:15pm-3pm: Bridal party pictures.
- 3pm-3:30pm: Family pictures.
- 3:30pm-4:30pm: Couple's pictures at venue.
- 4:30pm-5pm: Hide before ceremony.
- 5pm-5:30pm: Ceremony.
- 5:30pm-6:30pm: Cocktail hour (couple enjoys; photographer gets candids).
- 6:30pm: Guests seated; Grand Entrance.
- 6:45pm: Dinner; Couple's welcome speech.
- 7:30pm-7:35pm: Cake cutting.
- 7:30pm-7:50pm: Toasts.

7:50pm-8pm: Dancefloor prep.
8pm-8:15pm: First Dances.
8:15pm-8:50pm: Open dancing.
8:50pm-9pm: Grand Exit (e.g., sparklers).

# **Tips for a Smooth Day**

- Assign a point person for questions.
- Assign someone for family photo lists.
- Preparation: Champagne with bridesmaids, whisky with groomsmen.
- Exchange heartfelt letters/gifts pre-ceremony.
- Consider a "first look" for private portraits and a "first look" at the reception room.
- "First look" with parents.
- Include pets if desired.
- Special moment for grandparents.
- Ceremony kiss: make it long, then steal another down the aisle.
- Surprise thank-you speech to spouse/parents during dinner.
- Stay hydrated (electrolytes).
- Take 5-10 quiet minutes for yourselves.



# Minnesota Weddings

- Always have weather backup plans.
- Check Mayo Clinic conference schedules (can affect hotel rates).
- Inform guests about downtown parking.
- For winter weddings: allow extra travel time, consider hand warmers.
- Be mindful of Canada geese near water features (e.g., Silver Lake).
- Consider local businesses for welcome bags/favors.
- Have a "day-of" emergency kit.
