Booking Timeline

Budget Guidelines (Minnesota)
Beginner photographers: \$2,000+
Experienced professionals: \$3,000-\$5,000+

Questions to Ask Yourself First

Compare what's included, not just the final price!

Do you love their photography style?
Have you met the photographer? Do you feel comfortable with them?
Have you reviewed complete wedding galleries (not just highlights)?
Have you seen photos taken in dark venues similar to yours?
Are their online reviews authentic and recent?
How long have they been photographing weddings professionally?

Red Flags to Avoid

- Poor photo quality (blurry, bad lighting, poor composition)
- Bad reviews or slow communication
- Won't show complete wedding galleries
- Less than 3 years of wedding photography experience

No backup plans (equipment, photographer, insurance)	

Co	ontract & Payment Questions
	What happens if you have an emergency before our wedding?
	What's the payment schedule? (deposit amount, final payment timing)
	What are your cancellation/rescheduling policies?
	Are there travel fees beyond a certain distance?
	What happens if our wedding runs overtime?
	Do you carry professional liability insurance?
Eq	uipment & Technical Questions
	Will you personally be photographing our wedding (not a partner)?
	Do you have backup equipment if something breaks?
	Do you work with multiple cameras simultaneously?
	How do you handle dark venues? Do you use off-camera flash?
	What's your photo backup strategy during and after the wedding?
	Do you offer a second shooter option?
Ph	oto Delivery & Rights
	Do you outsource editing, or do you edit personally?
	How many edited photos will we receive?
	What's your delivery timeline?
	How will photos be delivered? (online gallery, USB, etc.)
	What rights do we have to print and share photos?

Are all delivered photos fully edited?
What's your social media posting policy?

	Do you offer wedding albums? What types?
	Who selects images and designs the album layout?
	Can we request layout changes?
	Do you offer albums for parents?
Co	ommunication & Planning
	How responsive are you during the planning process?
	Do you help create our wedding timeline?
	Can you provide references from recent clients?
	What's your weather contingency plan for outdoor weddings?
	When do you typically arrive and leave?
	Are you comfortable recreating specific shots we've seen?
En	agagement Session & Family Photos
	Is an engagement session included?
	How many outfit changes are allowed?
	Where can we shoot the engagement session?
	How do you handle large family group coordination?
	Do you provide a family photo shot list template?
